Newcastle Local Municipality proposes to construct a 1,6km PVC bulk sewer pipe of 200mm diameter in Madadeni H39. The proposed pipeline will be a rising main from the pump station. From the proposed pump station the sewer will be pumped and it will discharge in a manhole of an existing 1050mm diameter bulk sewer line. The estimated flows through the pipeline are as follows: Q peak = 25l/s Head 19m
