Proposed establishment of approxiamately 500 hectares of Beema Bamboo Plantation, KwaDukuza and Mandeni Local Municipalities, Ilembe District Municipality

We acknowledge receipt of your invitation for comment with regards to the proposed development. The object of Amafa is to administer, conserve and protect heritage resources of the Province within the terms of KZN Heritage Act no. 4 (2008) and the National Heritage Resources Act No 25 of 1999. The area of proposed development is generally sensitive in terms of heritage values. The Environmental Management Framework of the area highlights the need for a systematic study of the area because of the extensive nature of human interaction across this cultural landscape. The results of the mapping revealed that the greatest majority of the heritage resources in this area consist of

archaeological resources, pertaining to the Iron Age settlement of the area by farming communities over the last 1500 years.

Considering the heritage value of the area of proposed development, **a Heritage Impact Assessment is required for the above proposed project** in terms of the KwaZulu Natal Heritage Act No. 4 of 2008 and the National Heritage Resources Act No.25 of 1999 (Section 38 (1)). This must include the archaeological component (Phase 1) and any other applicable heritage components. Amafa KZN Heritage therefore requires the appointment of an Amafa accredited Heritage Practitioner to assist in the provision of recommendations and mitigation procedures.
