The eThekweni Municipality proposes the construction of a pedestrian bridge over the Wewe River in Burbreeze, Tongaat.

Thank you for notifying us about the proposed development as cited above. The documents attached including the Heritage Impact Assessment report have been reviewed. It has been established that the development is not likely to impact on any resources as none were noted on the surface. This does not rule out the possibility of sub-surface finds.

Since the surface survey by Frans Prins of Active Heritage did not identify heritage sites or features on the footprint and its immediate environment, Amafa has no objection to the development as outlined in the Basic Assessment Report.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
4. Sources of all natural materials (including topsoil, sands, natural gravels, crushed stone, asphalt, etc.) must be obtained in a sustainable manner and in compliance with the heritage legislation.
