### **Heritage Impact Assessment for the Proposed Sunway / Refentse Outfall Sewer, Within the Madibeng Local Municipality, in the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality, North West Province.**

Landscape Architect Environmental Planner (LEAP) appointed G & H Heritage Management Consultants to conduct a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) for the proposed Sunway/Refentse Outfall Sewer on the Farm Rietfontein 485JQ within the Madibeng Local Municipality, North West Province.
