BNL Nnake Trading has been appointed by Autumn Skies Trading 689 to conduct an Environmental Authorisation (EA) Application process and Prospecting Right Application for prospecting activities on farms Hounslow 323 and Koegas 324 in the Magisterial District of Hay, Northern Cape.

A Scoping Report in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 107 of 1998 (NEMA), NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, No 28 of 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended), has been submitted.

It is noted that a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) conducted for the farms on the opposite side of the river have been submitted as part of this application. Several heritage resources including a grave was identified as part of that assessment. No assessment of the impact to palaeontological resources was submitted as part of this application.

Interim Comment

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit requests that an application specific HIA be conducted for the proposed prospecting activities on farms Hounslow 323 and Koegas 324 as part of the EIA phase of the application in terms of section 38(3) and 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA). The HIA must include an assessment of archaeological and palaeontological resources.

The quickest process to follow for the archaeological component would be to contract a specialist (see www.asapa.org.za or www.aphp.org.za to provide an Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA). The location of the development must be mapped on the GIS layer of the SAHRIS application in order for an informed comment to be issued.
