A draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAr) has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, no 107 of 1998 (NEMA), NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations. The proposed projects include a new Return Water Dam (RWD) 3 and King Water Containment Facility, Pipelines project and an amendment to the Water Use Licence (WUL).

Two Heritage Impact Assessments (HIA) have been submitted as part of the EA application in terms of section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA).

A total of four cemeteries, surfaces scatters of Stone Age artefacts, one high density surface scatter of Stone Age lithics and Later Iron Age potsherds were identified within the surveyed footprint. Recommendations in the report include surface collection of specific Stone Age and Iron Age occurrences, long-term management of heritage resources that are to remain *in-situ* and a monitoring procedure be implemented.
