Ilima Coal Company (Pty) Ltd propose to establish an underground and surface mining coal mine on the farm Kranspan 49 IT, Chief Albert Luthuli Local Municipality of Mpumalanga Province. The extent of the proposed mine right area is 3 382 ha consisting of 1054 ha for the open cast pit, 93 ha for the overburden stockpile, 11 ha for the topsoil stockpile, 2 ha for the mine contractor camp, 6 ha for the Pollution Control dams and 5.3 ha for the Coal stockpile area. The underground mine area will be 392 ha with a 5.4 ha mine shaft area with the support infrastructure amounting to 4 ha and a 2.4 km overland conveyor to the coal stockpile area.

ABS Africa Sustainability Advisors (Pty) Ltd have been appointed by Ilima Coal Company (Pty) Ltd to undertake the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process in respect of listed activities in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2017 as amended, that require an application for Environmental Authorisation in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA), as amended. As well as a water use licence in terms of the National Water Act (Act No.36 of 1998) (NWA) under Section 21(c) and (i) Water Uses. As well as a Mine Right in terms of section 22 of the Minerals and Petroleum Resources Development Act, Act 28 of 2002 (MPRDA).
