Construction of a 592m 22kV woodpole power line on the farm Probeerfontein in the Douglas area in the Northern Cape Province.

Eskom has submitted an application in terms of section 38(1) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) for a proposed 22kV powerline to be constructed adjacent the Orange River, on the farm Probeerfontein 7, near Douglas, Northern Cape Province. The proposed powerline will be 592 m long.

The proposed development is located in an area of moderate palaeontological sensitivity as per the SAHRIS PalaeoSensitivity map. The proposed line route is located adjacent the Orange River in a relatively undisturbed area. No ground level photographs have been provided.

Response to NID

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit requests that a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) inclusive of an archaeological and palaeontological component be conducted for the proposed development as per section 38(3) of the NHRA. The reports must be completed by a qualified archaeologist and palaeontologist and the reports must comply with the SAHRA 2007 Minimum Standards: Archaeological and Palaeontological Components of Impact Assessments and the SAHRA 2012 Minimum Standards: Palaeontological Component of Heritage Impact Assessments.
