Response to NID (Notification of Intent to Develop)

Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd, Limpopo Operating Unit (LOU) intends to construct the power line for the above-mentioned project. The power line will include new 0.454 KM MV which will T-off from the existing power line in pole number BBL258/75/19/8 (refer to the Span plan sheets and the Pegging Coordinates for more information) traversing on the Rem of Farm The Bul Bul 5-LS in Blouberg Local Municipality of Capricorn District Municipality of the Limpopo Province

Eskom SOC Ltd, Limpopo Operating Unit (LOU) is requesting, on behalf of their applicant, that SAHRA grant them an exemption from conducting heritage studies for this proposed power line development. According to the documents submitted to the case, the proposed new power line will be 454m starting at Blouberg 22 kV feeder, and located on the remainder of the farm The Bul Bul 5 LR in the Blouberg Local Municipality of Limpopo Province. The power line will be supplying electricity to a borehole in a rural village in Senwabarana.

SAHRA Response to Notification of Development

This application constitutes a section 38 (1) application for approval by SAHRA in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act, no 25 of 1999 (NHRA), as the proposed power line exceeds 300 metres in length. However, SAHRA cannot provide a response in terms of section 38(2) for this application because a detailed .kml file has not been submitted to the case. The power line must be mapped fully on google earth and the .kml file must be uploaded to the case for assessment.

A new .kml file that indicates the power line route using line should be created on google earth and uploaded to the case.

SAHRA will respond to the NID once this information is uploaded to the case.
