Thank you for the report regarding the burials younger than 60 years located near the Late Iron Age burial that was exhumed as part of permit #3048 in terms of section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA). The graves younger than 60 years old are not protected by the NHRA and SAHRA has no jurisdiction to make comment on any actions taken with regards to relocation or in-situ management for these burials. The LIA burials were exhumed and relocated as per the Final Report provided by A Pelser, 2020 in line with permit conditions.

SAHRA considers the matter to be closed.
