## Final Comment

**In terms of Section 38(4), 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)**

Attention: Humansrus Solar 3 (Pty) Ltd

**The applicant has applied to amend the Environmental Authorisation for Humansrus Solar 3 to incorporate a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) with a total footprint of up to 4ha within the previously assessed area. The original case ID was 9460 and SAHRA issued a final comment on Wednesday June 29, 2016.**

Cape EA Prac has been appointed by Humansrus Solar 3 (Pty) Ltd to conduct an Environmental Authorisation (EA) Amendment Application process for the authorised Humansrus Solar 3 Photovoltaic facility, near Copperton, Northern Cape Province (DEA Ref: 14/12/16/3/3/2/888).

A Final Motivation Report has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, no 107 of 1998 (NEMA) and the NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations. The proposed amendment will include the installation of a battery energy storage system (BESS) within the authorised footprint, covering up to 4 ha.

In a previous SAHRIS Application (SAHRIS Case ID 9460 <https://sahris.sahra.org.za/cases/humansrus-solar-pv-energy-facility-3>), a Final Comment was issued on the 29/06/2016 noting no objections to the development and provided conditions (<https://sahris.sahra.org.za/node/365375>).

Natura Viva CC and Dr Lita Webley were appointed to provide heritage specialist input as part of the EA Amendment application report as required by section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA and section 38(3) and 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA).

*Almond, J. E. 2020. Palaeontological Heritage Resources Comment: Proposed Battery Energy Storage System for the Authorised Humansrus Solar 3 PV Facility on Farm 147 (Humansrus) near Copperton, Siyathemba Municipality, Northern Cape.*

The specialist confirmed that the inclusion of the BESS would not change the nature or significance of the impacts assessed in the original Palaeontological Assessment, nor would it result in additional impacts that

The specialist confirmed that no new impacts to heritage are excepted with the proposed 2020 amendments. No additional management outcomes or mitigation measures were recommended.

## Final Comment

The following comments are made as a requirement in terms of section 3(4) of the NEMA Regulations and section 38(8) of the NHRA in the format provided in section 38(4) of the NHRA and must be included in the Final Motivation Report and EMPr:

- 38(4)a – The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit has no objections to the proposed amendment to the authorised development;
- 38(4)b – The recommendations of the specialists are supported and must be adhered to. Further additional specific conditions are provided for the development as follows;
- The conditions contained within the Interim Comment issued on the 29/06/2016 on SAHRIS Case ID 9460 are valid and must be adhered to;
- 38(4)c(i) – If any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g. remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments, charcoal and ash concentrations), fossils or other categories of heritage resources are found during the proposed development, SAHRA APM Unit (Natasha Higgitt/Phillip Hine 021 462 5402) must be alerted as per section 35(3) of the NHRA. Non-compliance with section of the NHRA is an offense in terms of section 51(1)e of the NHRA and item 5 of the Schedule;
- 38(4)c(ii) – If unmarked human burials are uncovered, the SAHRA Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit (Thingahangwi Tshivhase/Mimi Seetelo 012 320 8490), must be alerted immediately as per section 36(6) of the NHRA. Non-compliance with section of the NHRA is an offense in terms of section 51(1)e of the NHRA and item 5 of the Schedule;
- 38(4)d – See section 51(1) of the NHRA;
- 38(4)e – The following conditions apply with regards to the appointment of specialists:
  - i) If heritage resources are uncovered during the course of the development, a professional archaeologist or palaeontologist, depending on the nature of the finds, must be contracted as soon as possible to inspect the heritage resource. If the newly discovered heritage resources prove to be of

Proof of the delivery and receipt thereof must be uploaded to this case for record keeping purposes;
- The decision regarding the EA Amendment Application must be communicated to SAHRA and uploaded to the SAHRIS Case application.
