Final Decision

In terms of Section 38(2) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Eskom Distribution, Mpumalanga Operating Unit(MOU) is proposing to build a 841m, 22kV powerline from the Oakley feeder near Bushbuckridge. The project will be within the Marite 287 KU farm, Ehlanzeni District Municipality, Bushbuckridge Local Municipality, Mpumalanga Province. The project will involve digging 2.4m deep holes with the area of 2mX2m to plant 14m wooden poles and stringing the 22 KV powerline to interconnect with another feeder line.

Eskom SOC Ltd, Mpumalanga Operating Unit (MOU) is proposing to construct a new power line on behalf of their applicant, to supplying electricity to a household in the village. The photos provided to the case do not show any surface heritage features therefore, the potential impact on heritage resources is considered low. The construction of a 22 kV power line along the gravel road will not change the character of the landscape. The likelihood of heritage artefacts being uncovered from the foundation excavations is low. There will be no impact to palaeontological resources as the area is in a grey zone according to the SAHRIS palaeosensitivity map.

Final Decision

SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit grants this application an exemption from further heritage assessments in terms of section 38(2)b of the National Heritage Resources Act, no 25 of 1999 (NHRA).

SAHRA has no objections to this proposed development going ahead and this Final Decision applies to the provisions of the NHRA only.
