Interim Comment

Xakwa Coal (Pty) Ltd is applying for an Integrated Environmental Authorisation and a Mining Right. The mining of coal will occur on portions 6, 7, 13 and 16 of the farm Modderfontein 236 IR, situated within the Magisterial District of Delmas, Mpumalanga.

Xakwa Coal (Pty) Ltd have appointed Geovicon Environmental (Pty) Ltd to undertake an environmental assessment as part of the Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment Reporting process in support of an Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environment Management Act, Act 107 of 1998 (NEMA) for activities that trigger the NEMA EIA 2014 Regulations. As well as the requirements of the Minerals and Petroleum Resources Development Act, No 28 of 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended).

A Scoping report was submitted to the South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA) for commenting in terms of section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA). The Scoping report states that a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) was commissioned but the report does not mention whether a Palaeontological impact assessment will be undertaken as well.

Interim Comment

The HIA report must be undertaken by a suitably qualified archaeologist.

The proposed development area is located within an area of very high sensitivity in terms of palaeontological resources as per the SAHRIS PalaeoSensitivity. The dBAR notes that the development area is underlain by the highly fossiliferous Karoo Supergroup formations, as such, a field-based Palaeontological Impact Assessment (PIA) must be undertaken by a qualified palaeontologist (See https://www.palaeosa.org/heritage-practitioners.html for a list of qualified palaeontologists). The report must comply with the 2012 Minimum Standards: Palaeontological Components of Heritage Impact Assessments.
