E VD Engineering has submitted a section 38(1) of the National Heritage Resources Act, no 25 of 1999 (NHRA) application, on behalf of their applicant, to obtain a SAHRA decision in terms of section 38(2) of the NHRA for the construction of a 2221m power line starting from Waterberg/Afguns 22kV, on Portion 1 and the remainder of the farm Bankfontein 686 LQ and Dwarsfontein 680 LQ, in the Limpopo Province.

SAHRA issued an Interim Comment dated 30/11/2021 requesting additional information and ground level photographs of the power line route. The wayleave and desd documents were submitted to the case on 08/02/2022.

Final Decision

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit accepts application and all the supporting documents for this proposed power line route. Therefore, in terms of section 38(2)b of the National Heritage Resources Act, no 25 of 1999 (NHRA) the proposed development is granted an exemption from undertaking a Heritage Impact Assessment.

The SAHRA has no objections to this proposed development going ahead and this Final Decision applies to the provisions of the NHRA only.
