## **Interim Comment**

In terms of Section 38(3), 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Attention: Lesego Diamond Mining (Pty) Ltd

The proposed Prospecting Right combined with a Waste Licence application to prospect for Diamond DIA, Diamond (Alluvial), Diamond (General) and Diamond (In Kimberlite) near Barkly West on the Remaining Extent of the Farm 225, Registration Division: Barkly West, Northern Cape province.

Milnex Environmental Consultants CC have been appointed by Lesego Diamond Mining (Pty) Ltd to undertake an Environmental Authorisation Application for proposed prospecting activities on the Remaining Extent of the Farm 225, Registration Division: Barkly West, Northern Cape Province (NC30/5/1/2/2/13003PR).

A Draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report (DEIA) has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the EIA Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). The proposed prospecting application area will cover 1 776.2518 ha and will include 100 pits (4 m x 2 m x 3 m) and 50 trenches (40 m x 40 m x 3 m), ablution facility, and storage of dangerous goods.

The applicant is advised to extend the EA process in terms of section 23(1)b of the NEMA EIA Regulations in order to comply with this comment. A revised EIA with the results of the above requested specialist studies must be completed.
