## **Final Decision**

In terms of Section 38(3), 38(4), 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Attention: Xolandani Siphiwudumo (Pty) Ltd

Mining Permit to mine Coal on portion of Portion 32 of the farm Blesboklaagte 296 JS, Magisterial District of Nkangala, Mpumalanga Province.

Singo Consulting (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by Xolandani Siphiwudumo (Pty) Ltd to undertake an Environmental Authorisation Application for proposed mining activities on Portion 32 of the farm Blesboklaagte 296 JS, near Ackerville, Mpumalanga Province (MP 30/5/1/1/3/13283 MP).

In an Interim Comment issued on the 06/09/2022, SAHRA requested that an assessment of the impact to heritage resources be undertaken as per section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA and section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) that complies with section 38(3) of the NHRA.

A draft Basic Assessment Report (DBAR) was submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the EIA Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). No assessment of the impact to heritage resources had been conducted as per section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA and section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) that complies with section 38(3) of the NHRA.

In a Final Comment issued on the 24/10/2022, it was stated that SAHRA could not endorse this proposed development as the impact to heritage resources as required by section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA and section 38(3) and 38(8) of the NHRA has not been conducted as part of the EA process. SAHRA advised the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) to reject the application for Mining Permit activities on Portion 32 of the farm Blesboklaagte 296 JS, near Ackerville, Mpumalanga Province (MP 30/5/1/1/3/13283 MP).

Since the issuing of the Final Comment, a letter of motivation has been submitted, where the EAP is requesting not to conduct a Heritage Impact Assessment as the area is highly disturbed and that there were no signs of any heritage components.
