Singo Consulting (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by Notre Coal (Pty) Ltd to undertake an Environmental Authorisation Application for proposed prospecting activities on portion 1 and a portion of the Remaining Extent of the Farm Annysspruit 140 HT, near Piet Retief, Mpumalanga Province (MP 30/5/1/1/2/17554 PR).

In an Interim Comment issued on the 26/09/2022, SAHRA requested that an assessment of the impact to heritage resources be undertaken as per section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA and section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) that complies with section 38(3) of the NHRA.

A draft Basic Assessment Report (DBAR) has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the EIA Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). The proposed prospecting activities 15 boreholes (locations of these are known), mobile office and toilets, parking, access road, guard room, geological logging area, waste area, clean and dirty sump, diesel and water storage

The DBAR notes that a qualified archaeologist inspect the proposed prospecting sites prior to drilling to establish whether the sites may be sensitive from a heritage perspective. However, no assessment of the impact to heritage resources has been conducted as part of the EA application as per section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA and section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) that complies with section 38(3) of the NHRA.

Final Comment

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit cannot endorse this proposed development and advises the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) to reject the application for prospecting activities on portion 1 and a portion of the Remaining Extent of the Farm Annysspruit 140 HT,
