Interim Comment

In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Attention: Palladium Solar Power Plant (RF) (PTY) Ltd

The activities entail the development of an up to 250MW photovoltaic solar facility and associated infrastructure, on Portion 1 of the farm Makayskraal No. 18 and Portion 2 of the farm Tusschenkomst No. 15, Limpopo Province situated within the Thabazimbi Local Municipality area of jurisdiction. The town of Northam is located approximately 2 km north of the proposed development. The project entails the generation of up to 250MW electrical power through photovoltaic (PV) panels. The total footprint of the project will be approximately 778 hectares (including supporting infrastructure on site).

Palladium Solar Power Plant (RF) (Pty) Ltd have appointed Environamics (Pty) Ltd to undertake a Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment application process in support for an Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, Act no 107 of 1998 (NEMA) as amended, for activities that trigger the NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) 2014 Regulations, as amended.

Palladium Solar Plant is proposing to construct a 250MW Solar PV facility with associated supporting infrastructure on 778 ha of land. This will include a 132KV substation and transformer, as well as a BESS and a 88kV power line to the existing Eskom 275kV or 400kV lines from Spitskop 400/275/88/kV MTS Substation. The PV plant will be located on Portion 3 and 4 of the farm Zwartdoorns 421 KQ, and the power line will be crossing the farms Tusschenkomst 15 KQ, Nooitgedacht 11 KQ, Makayskraal 18 KQ, De Put 412 KQ, Wildebeestlaagte 411 KQ, Grootkuil 409 KQ, Spitskop 410 KQ, situated within the Thabazimbi Local Municipality of the Limpopo Province.

A BID has been submitted to SAHRA for commenting in terms of section 38 of the National Heritage Resources Act, no. 25 of 1999 (NHRA). An Interim Comment acknowledging the BID was issued by SAHRA on 06/02/2023. The Scoping Report was submitted 30/06/2023.

The SAHRA issued an Interim Comment dated 31/01/2023 requesting the submission of a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) report, and a Palaeontology Impact Assessment (PIA). The HIA report by APelser Archaeological Consulting cc and PIA report by Banzai Environmental were submitted on 06/06/2023.

PALLADIUM SPP DEVELOPMENT

ON VARIOUS FARMS AND FARM PORTIONS NEAR NORTHAM, IN THE WATERBERG DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY THABAZIMBI LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF THE LIMPOPO PROVINCE.

The author undertook a field assessment and identified isolated Later Iron Aged potsherds and upper grinding stones along a gravel road between the the Palladium SPP and Copper SPP, and a historical concrete dam. The author recommends the retention of sites 1, 4, 7, and 8) *in situ*, sites 1 and 8 must be fenced with an access gate, and the vegetation must be kept short that all identified sites in the development must be included in a Cultural Heritage Management Plan (CHMP).

The study area is underlain by igneous rocks of the Nebo Granite (Lebowa Granite Suite) and the Rustenburg Layered Suite of the Bushveld Complex as well as sedimentary rocks of the Timeball Hill Formation of the Pretoria Group (Transvaal Supergroup). Updated geology maps indicates that the development is underlain by Nebo Granite and the Bierkraal Subsuite as well as the Timeball Hill Formation (Pretoria Group, Transvaal Supergroup). The granite suites are of negligible palaeosensitivity, and high for the Timeball Hill Formation. The author recommends the following:

The ECO for this project must be informed that the Timeball Hill Formation has a Very High Palaeontological Sensitivity.

If Palaeontological Heritage is uncovered during surface clearing and excavations the Chance find Protocol attached should be implemented immediately. Fossil discoveries ought to be protected and the ECO/site manager must report to South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA) so that mitigation (recording and collection) can be carried out.

Before any fossil material can be collected from the development site the specialist involved would need to apply for a collection permit from SAHRA. Fossil material must be housed in an official collection (museum or university), while all reports and fieldwork should meet the minimum standards for palaeontological impact studies proposed by SAHRA (2012).

These recommendations should be incorporated into the Environmental Management Plan for the Palladium Solar Power Plant.
