A Draft Scoping Report has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the EIA Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). The proposed activities will include opencast mining, blasting, access and haul roads, offices with ablution facilities, weighbridge, workshop and store, diesel facilities and hardstand, powerline and water pipelines, stockpiles, surface water management infrastructure, and crushing and screening facilities within an application area of 2 736.340 ha.

The DSR states that a Heritage Impact Assessment inclusive of a Palaeontological Impact Assessment will be conducted as part of the EIA phase of the EA application.

SAHRA requests that the pending assessment of the impacts to heritage resources complies with section 38(3) of the NHRA as required by section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) and section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA be conducted as <u>part of the EA process</u>.

The assessment must include an assessment of the impact to archaeological and palaeontological resources. The field-based assessment of archaeological resources must be conducted by a qualified archaeologist and the report comply with the SAHRA 2007 Minimum Standards: Archaeological and Palaeontological Components of Impact Assessment Reports (see www.asapa.co.za or www.asapa.co.za for a list of qualified archaeologists).
