Eskom proposes the construction of a 339 km 22Kv power line on the remaining extent of farm Orinoco 233 KU near Dwarsloop, Bushbuckridge Local Municipality, Mpumalanga Province. Considering the limited footprint of the power line and its location within a residential area, SAHRA is of the opinion that it is unlikely that significant heritage resources will be encountered during the construction.
