## In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Attention: Tshivhase Traditional Authority

Proposed Establishment of Residential, Tourism Accommodation, Recreational, Educational and Conference Facilities as well as Supporting Infrastructure in the proposed Tshivhase Nature Reserve at Vondo Dam Within Thulamela Local Municipality of Vhembe District Municipality, Limpopo Province

Thulamela Local Municipality, is trying to establish the Tshivase Nature Reserve resort on state-land near the Vondo Dam. This will include the construction of accommodation houses, offices, hiking trails and bush huts.

Under sections 34, 35 and 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act (25 of 1999) heritage resources are protected. These resources are for instance burial grounds, unmarked and marked graves that are older than 60 years, built structures that are older than 60 years old, archaeology (stone tools, stone walled sites, prehistoric and historic pottery sherds, ash grounds etc.) and palaeontology (fossils of plant and animal material).

The field assessment to find any potential heritage resources within the proposed nature reserve found a single grave. No further heritage studies

### **Final Comment**

SAHRA agrees with the recommendations made in the heritage report referenced in this comment as follows:

- The single grave should be fenced along a 10m buffer zone area around the perimeter of the grave, the fence should have an entrance gate to accessed by living relatives of the grave when requested.

- A Site Conservation Plan needs to be submitted to SAHRA in the same case on SAHRIS. The CMP should detail monitoring, conservation and repairs procedure of the fence, as well as grave if damaged by any activities during construction and operation of the Resort.
