Zeerust: Specialist Archaeological Services for the Implementation of the SAHRA-Approved Cultural Heritage Management Plan for the 75MW Zeerust Solar PV Energy Facility and Associated Infrastructure, Located on Portions of the Farms Kameeldoorn 271-JP and Kruisrivier 270-JP, Near Zeerust, North-West Province—Monitoring Site Visit 09th July 2020.

SAHRA issued final comments dated 14/10/2016, in acceptance of the CMP that details monitoring procedure, the fencing of the archaeological site and the provision for control of personal on site. The author has submitted the final monitoring report for the construction phase of the 75MW Zeerust Solar PV. The fence has been successfully installed, and debris from construction and litter was removed. The burial grounds identified for the 132kV power line have also been fenced.

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit accepts the final monitoring report and final audit report and supports the recommendation that the CMP must be renewed every 5 years. Starting at the end of the 5 year period of the current CMP.
