Interim Comment

The only document submitted to the case is the restoration specification assessment document of the old hospital, which does not mention the proposed construction of the new district hospital and the age of the current hospital including the history of the hospital is not provided. The minimum required information for a historical structure should be the history of the construction, planning and operation of the hospital and surrounding buildings, the age of the buildings should be identified in order for its significance to be determined. Ideally a historical architect or local historian should be contacted to supply a report containing such information.
