Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd, Limpopo Operating Unit (LOU) hereby notifying you that it intends to electrify Ga-Rapadi Village, The MV and LV lines are more than 300m in size which will T-off from the existing powerline in pole number VNM476/22/73/33/23/8 refer to the Span plan sheets and the Pegging Coordinates for more information, traversing in farm Kafferboom 664LR in Lephalale Local Municipality of Waterberg District Municipality of the Limpopo Province.

Eskom SOC Ltd, Limpopo Operating Unit (LOU) is requesting, on behalf of their applicant, that SAHRA grant them an exemption from conducting heritage studies for this proposed power line development. According to the documents submitted to the case, the proposed MV and LV lines are more than 300m and will be erected for the electrification of Ga-Rapadi Village on the farm Kafferboom 664LR in Lephalale Local Municipality of Waterberg District Municipality of the Limpopo Province.

The proposed development is located in an area of moderate palaeontological sensitivity as per the SAHRIS PalaeoSensitivity map. It is noted that the photos provided do not show any surface heritage features and potential impact on heritage resources is considered low.

Response to NID

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit notes that the proposed powerline may impact sensitive palaeontological deposits as it is located in an area of moderate palaeontological sensitivity as per the PaleoMap on SAHRIS.

Therefore, the SAHRA APM Unit requests that a desktop Palaeontological Impact Assessment (PIA) be conducted by a qualified palaeontologist.

The PIA report must adhere to the SAHRA 2006 Minimum Standards: Archaeological and Palaeontological Component of Impact Assessments and SAHRA 2012 Minimum Standards: Palaeontological Component of Heritage Impact Assessments makes reference to a Letter of Recommendation for Exemption that is to be submitted if there is no likelihood that heritage sites will be impacted. The appointed palaeontologist may choose to submit such a letter should they deem it appropriate.
