The proposed project relates to the restoration and upgrade of the Lemana College Campus, near Elim, Limpopo Province, as part of the Historic Schools Project. According to the heritage report that has been submitted to SAHRA, the restoration that will be undertaken is reversible and that only buildings of recent age will be demolished. The goal of the project is to restore the historic character of the Lemana College Campus.

Considering the fact that the proposed renovations will not have any impact on potential archaeological or palaeontological resources and that this is not a National Heritage Site, any decisions regarding the proposed project will have to be referred to the Limpopo Heritage Resources Authority (Mr Donal Lithole, [litholek@sac.limpopo.gov.za](mailto:litholek@sac.limpopo.gov.za)).

If any archaeological heritage resources are found during construction activities, SAHRA APM Unit (Mrs Colette Scheermeyer/Mr Phillip Hine, tel. 021 462 4502) and an archaeologist must be alerted immediately. If the newly discovered heritage resource is considered significant, a rescue excavation may be required at the cost of the developer.
