Thank you for your indication that development is to take place in this area.

It is noted that the application submitted to SAHRA is for rectification of unlawful activities in terms of Section 24G of the National Environmental Management Act (Act no 107 of 1998). It is further noted on page 31 of the Rectification Application that the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) states that no archaeological or any other heritage sites could immediately be identified to exist on the property and that the existing farm house has been extensively modified.

However, for SAHRA to provide an exemption for this application further information is required. It is recommended that the project team engage a heritage specialist to provide SAHRA with a Letter of Exemption from further heritage studies. As soon as this document is submitted SAHRA will issue a Final Comment on the case.
