Thank you for your indication that development is to take place in this area.

It is noted that on page 60 of the Scoping Report that Dr David Morris will undertake a Heritage Impact Assessment and that the results will be incorporated into the Environmental and Social Impact Assessment. Please note that the heritage study will have to be submitted to SAHRA for approval before Final Decision is granted by the competent authority. According to the SAHRA palaeontological sensitivity map and the information provided in the Scoping Report the possible impacts on potential palaeontological resources are considered to be low. This project is therefore exempted from further palaeontological studies.

Any other heritage resources that may be impacted such as built structures over 60 years old, sites of cultural significance associated with oral histories, burial grounds and graves, graves of victims of conflict, and cultural landscapes or viewsapes must also be assessed.
