A transformer will be installed for sufficient electricity supply. There is adequate water available onsite. Effluent will be piped to an existing effluent lagoon via a new pipeline. A Concrete Effluent Storage Tank will be installed and will have capacity to store two days worth of effluent.

We acknowledge receipt of your invitation for comment with regards to the proposed development.
