eThekweni Water and Sanitation (EWS) propose two ablution blocks, a pump station and associated pipework in uMlazi V to provide formal sanitation facilities to the informal settlement in the area. Sections of the proposed pipelines and the pump station fall within 32 meters of a watercourse. Cumulatively, the pipelines will be longer than 300m and therefore AMAFA is required to comment on the application.

As highlighted in the WP 265 letter, the case has been discussed and the decision stands. You are required to appoint a Heritage Impact Assessment Practitioner as per our previous comment/decision as this will eventually be to the developer's advantage. The general area of proposed development is a known sensitive area where the possibility of encountering heritage finds is high. The HIA will help pre-empt possible problems of unnecessary delay due to the onerous permitting process that can take more than four weeks due to the gazetting requirement.
