We acknowledge receipt of the Retail Park application incorporating the HIA for the whole Cornubia Mixed Development Area done by eThembeni in 2007 and identified four heritage resouces: Two structures over 60 years, Graves and an Archaeological Site.

We note that the EIA Practitioner indicates that the Retail Park is not located in the area where the Heritage Resources were noted in the 2007 study. Mitigation of these four resources should be highlighted to the construction team and the ECO to ensure that they remain protected from accidental damage.

In view of the findings outlined in the HIA Report by Len Schalkwyk and Elizabeth Wahl (ETHEMBENI CULTURAL HERITAGE) that we received for the above proposed development, in terms of KwaZulu Natal Heritage Act No. 4 of 2008 and the National Heritage Resources Act No.25 of 1999 (Section 38 (1), we have no objection to the proposed development within limits of the prescribed mitigation measures and recommendations.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned conditions:

Conditions:

- 1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
- 2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished, altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
- 3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site which contains rock art.
- 4. Amafa should be contacted if any graves are identified during construction and the following procedure is to be followed:
- stop construction
- · report finding to local police station
- report to Amafa to investigate.
