DEVIATIONS TO APPROVED PLANS FOR THE ALTERATIONS & ADDITIONS: CORNER RAILWAY STREET (PIETERMARITZBURG RAILWAY STATION), PIETERMARITZBURG, MSUNDUZI

The permit application in respect of the above, received on the 13 February 2013, and deviations report received in November 2013, reviewed by the Built Environment Committee on the 21 November 2013 refers. Please be advised as follows:

Turret/Cupola: The inspection of the cupola on the 28 November 2013 revealed that there was minimal damage to the roof and the turret roof. The roof would have to be repaired to take the turret in any event. The posts were damaged but these could be easily replaced and at minimal cost. The loss of the original fabric is not acceptable and the original must be repaired and reinstated. The fibre glass cupola roof was commissioned without prior Amafa approval and the costs of that exercise must be borne by those responsible as Amafa takes no responsibility for any losses incurred.

Fireplace tiles on the surround: it was agreed that salvaged existing tiles should be used together with new tiles – samples to be provided for final approval.

Canopy over side entrance to platform: there was no objection to this element being retained.
