



Final Comment

In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999) and the KwaZulu-Natal Heritage Act (Act 4 of 2008)

Attention: KZN Department of Transport

The KZN Department of Transport (DOT) proposes to extend Mlindazwe Road to a type 7A local gravel road approximately 6.1km in length and 6m in width with a road reserve of 20m that conforms to DOT standards. The existing road will be upgraded in one of Msinga villages off D1271. The existing track is 1.8km in length, therefore DOT proposes to extend the existing track to a further 4.3km.

We acknowledge receipt of your invitation for comment with regards to the proposed development. It has been established through the heritage Impact Assessment by Frans Prins that there are no archaeological and historical sites on the footprint. No graves occur within 20m from the proposed road. No heritage resources were noted in the radius of 50m.

Amafa therefore has no objection to the proposed development .

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
4. Sources of all natural materials (including topsoil, sands, natural gravels, crushed stone, asphalt, etc.) must be obtained in a sustainable manner and in compliance with the heritage legislation.
