Eskom has been requested by Ratlou Local Municipality to electrify Ramabesa village. This project is on the priority list of the Ratlou Local Municipality and it forms part of 2023-24 financial year. The village falls under Stella CNC in Matlosana Zone. The development has a total of 29 new stands with 100% occupancy. From 29 stands, 12 are brick and 17 are of Tin type houses. The development currently has no services installed.

Eskom North West Operating Unit (NWOU) submitted an application in terms of section 38(1) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) for a proposed 22kV for the electrification of a small extension of the Ramabesa Village located on the remaining extent of the farm Setlagoli 304 IO, North West Province.

The project will electrify 29 new stands and the poweline will be constructed next to the gravel roads between the houses. The powerline is located in an area of moderate palaeontological sensitivity in terms of the PalaeoSensitivity Map on SAHRIS, which is covered by sandy soil in a fairly flat area. It is noted that no impact to heritage resources is expected.
