# The proposed upgrade of the Guswini track to a Type 7A Road Standard by the Msinga Municipality. The road is located in the Keates Drift area in the Msinga Municipality on erf Tugela Location 4674, KwaZulu-Natal.

Thank you for furnishing us with the heritage Impact Assessment Report on the road upgrade. It is noed that the survey by Staphan Gaigher established that there is an informal rural church site as well as a site with burials along the side of the proposed road upgrade .The construction activities pose a threat to the identified heritage resources and therefore there is need for a monitoring of construction and site clearance activities by the heritage practitioner.

A copy of the HIA report should be kept on site for use or reference by the construction team and the ECO.

In view of the findings outlined in the HIA Report by Stephan Gaigher of G & A Heritage that we received for the above proposed development, we have no objection to the proposed development within limits of the prescribed mitigation measures and recommendations.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

- 1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
- 2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
- 3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
- 4. Sources of all natural materials (including topsoil, sands, natural gravels, crushed stone, asphalt, etc.) must be obtained in a sustainable manner and in compliance with the heritage legislation.
