

REVIEW OF THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR THE CONTINUATION OF ASH DISPOSAL ACTIVITIES AT KENDAL POWER STATION.

Thank you for your indication that development is to take place in this area.

It is noted that on page 63 of the Draft Scoping Report that a Heritage Impact Assessment will be conducted for this particular project. In terms of the National Heritage Resources Act, no 25 of 1999, heritage resources, including archaeological or palaeontological sites over 100 years old, graves older than 60 years and structures older than 60 years are protected. They may not be disturbed without a permit from the relevant heritage resources authority.

In terms of Section 38(8) of the NHRA, before any development proposed in terms of NEMA(No. 14 of 2009) is approved, it is incumbent on the developer to ensure that any potential impacts to heritage resources are assessed to the satisfaction of the relevant heritage authority. Appropriate mitigation, which involves recording, sampling and dating sites that are to be destroyed, may be required depending on the nature and significance of the resources identified.
