Thank you for the invitation to comment on the development .We note that the survey by Gavin Anderson noted some buildings that are assumed to be below the 60 year trigger in terms of the KwaZulu Natal Heritage Act. Amafa concurs with the Cultural Resources Manager's recommendation that title deeds be produced for these structures should the need to disturb, demolish, alter or damage these structures arise. If the structures are over 60 years a permit will be required for any intrusive work on the structures. It is also noted that the Mavivane /Execution Cliff associated with the era of King Shaka occurs in the general area. The Heritage Practitioner should demarcate the 50m cultural zone as per the heritage report .

In view of the findings outlined in the Heritage Impact Assessment Report by Gavin Anderson of Umlando that we received for the above proposed development, we have no objection to the proposed development within limits of the prescribed mitigation measures and recommendations.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

- 1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
- 2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
- 3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
