Notice in terms of Section 9(3)(e) of the National Heritage Resources Act 25 OF 1999, for the decommissioning of the existing hand-drawn Malgas Pontoon

The South African Heritage Resources (SAHRA) has considered the emails received between 28 February and 8 March 2022 from the Western Cape Department of Transport and Public Works (DTPW). DTPW requests an extension on the process of appointing a conservator to produce a conservation management plan (CMP) and undertake a public participation process for decommissioning the old Malgas Pontoon.
