PERMIT: No. 80/01/11/010/51

I attach as requested a permit to undertake trial excavations only at Erf 742, corner of Mechau and Chiappini Streets, Green Point, Cape Town. In the event that human remains are uncovered, all activities on site should cease, and SAHRA should be notified immediately. Any application for a phase 2 permit for exhumation would have to be accompanied by a formal public participation process, with interested parties and communities as indicated in the Act and the regulations and by SAHRA.

The current process for this area is one which has been established by SAHRA, Heritage Western Cape and Cape Town City, and involves concurrent Sections 36 and 35 trial permits, issued by SAHRA and Heritage Western Cape, respectively. This is to ascertain, through limited trial excavations, whether this site is part of the historical burial ground. It will therefore be necessary to have obtained permits from both authorities before work at the site commences. As, in this instance, the permits have, unfortunately, not been given to a single permit holder, your role in this will include acting as Principal Investigator for the section 36 burial issues and monitoring the process very closely. Please ensure that you are in close contact with the other permit holder and with the developer and vice versa.
