The project involves the construction of 0.5 km tar road in Tugela Ferry area. The Tugela Ferry area falls within the Msinga Local Municipality in Umzinyathi District Municipality. The tar road will be constructed as Local Distributor roads (minor Bus Routes) in accordance with the Department of Transport specifications. The final road carriageway width will be twelve (12m) meters with blacktop. The proposed activity will take at the following property - Portion 25 of ERF 4665 on Farm Klipriver Native Location.

The application for comment in terms of heritage legislation has been considered and Amafa Heritage KwaZulu Natal has no objection to the development since the survey by eThembeni Cultural Heritage did not find any heritage resources on the development footprint.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects or resources are identified during site clearance and earth-moving activities. All development should cease until further notice.
2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
4. Sources of all natural materials (including topsoil, sands, natural gravels, crushed stone, asphalt, etc.) must be obtained in a sustainable manner and in compliance with the heritage legislation.

Failure to comply with the requirements of the National Heritage Resources Act and the KwaZulu Natal Heritage Resources Act could lead to legal action being instituted against the applicant.
