- Tuynhuys Fenceline Proposed, 2700 mm high fence on gracht wall.
- Tuynhuys Gratch Section fenceline Proposed 2700 mm fenceline.
- Tuynhuys Gateway wing wall Reinforce existing spikes and add smaller spikes in-between existing spikes.
- Tuynhuys Annex fenceline 3000 mm high secondary fenceline.
- Tuynhuys Forecourt Proposed, 2700 mm high fenceline on Gratch wall
