Thank you for the letter regarding the proposed mitigation measures for Site 1 a Late Iron Age site that was regarded as significant by the heritage specialist who undertook the Phase 1 Impact Assessment. It is noted that the mine proposes that the site be fenced and that no impact are to take place on the site.

SAHRA would support such an arrangement but recommends that an archaeologist be present during fencing of the site. It is further recommended that the fence should be maintained for the duration of the lifetime of the mine and that an information board be erected at the site.
