The Ashdown Stream is a tributary of the Msunduzi River. The meander has resulted in undercutting of the stream bank and has resulted in destabilisation of the area, which in turn has resulted in a dwelling (P15) being put at risk of collapse if further undercutting of the stream bank occurs. Rehabilitation and stabilization is required. The site is situated within Pietermaritzburg, KwaZulu-Natal.

Thank you for giving us an opportunity to comment on this development proposal in terms of heritage legislation. We have looked at the development proposal and do not consider the proposed activity to be a threat to any known heritage resources.

Amafa, the KZN Provincial Heritage Resources Authority has no objection to the development. You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

- 1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
- 2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
- 3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
- 4. Sources of all natural materials (including topsoil, sands, natural gravels, crushed stone, asphalt, etc.) must be obtained in a sustainable manner and in compliance with the heritage legislation.
