**In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999) and the KwaZulu-Natal Heritage Act (Act 4 of 2008)**

. The Project area lies in the centre of the Klip River Coalfield, and the surrounding areas currently support a number of coal mining operations and undeveloped coal resource blocks. The following farms form part of the Malonjeni block, Halzadene 12649, Corby Rock 11509, Lot W 8610, Terrace 3707, Rem of Eastkeal 5138 and ptn 8 of Winkle 5054. The proposed mining operations is planned for at least the next 15 years with a production rate of 960Kt/annum and a total ROM of 15 360 000 tonnes. The proposed underground coal mine located in the Malonjeni block approximately 16 km due east of Dundee, Kwa Zulu Natal

We acknowledge receipt of the site plan regarding the proposed Malonjeni Coal Mine, Dundee. We note the location of some of the heritage sites (including closest one to the mining boundary) relative to the extent of the entire mining application area, current proposed mining footprint, old mining footprint. We therefore request that you forward it to the Heritage Practitioner for further input on the impact of the mining activities on the heritage resources. We also still require a Cultural Heritage Management Plan for the entire mining application area.
