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Final Comment

In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999) and the KwaZulu-Natal Heritage Act (Act 4 of 2008)

Attention: Willcocks Reed & Kotze CC

Uthukela District Municipality proposes to construct approximately 56 kilometres of potable bulk water pipe mains ranging between 500 & 600mm Ø from the existing Observation Hill reservoir site in Ladysmith to Hobsland in the Driefontein Complex, from where it will extend further to the existing Zandbult Reservoir at Ekuvukeni. Phase 1 of the project from Observation Hill to Hobsland has already received approval. Phase 2 of the pipeline, for which this Basic Assessment is undertaken, is 49 km's long with the bulk water pipeline size 600mm Ø

We acknowledge receipt of the HIA Report on the Driefontein Pipeline. We note that some sites were noted some 100m away from the pipeline servitude and will therefore not be impacted on by the pipeline development. We also note that an addendum on the report was also produced to cover the preferred route. This route has no heritage resources within 20m of the servitude and will therefore not threaten any heritage resources.

In view of the findings outlined in the HIA Report by Frans Prins of Active Heritage that we received for the above proposed development, we have no objection to the proposed development within limits of the prescribed mitigation measures and recommendations.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

1. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
2. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
