Proposed forestry on a 9.8 hectares land at Umbumbulu, Sobonakhona tribal authority, kwaMbovu area.

We acknowledge receipt of your invitation for comment with regards to the proposed development. The object of Amafa is to administer, conserve and protect heritage resources of the Province within the terms of KZN Heritage Act no. 4 (2008) and the National Heritage Resources Act No 25 of 1999. While the archaeological potential of the Umbumbulu area is generally high, the area of proposed development was surveyed by Amafa officials revealing absence of surface heritage resources. The nature of proposed activity is in-keeping with previous land use and will occur within a transformed environment.

The proposed stream flow reduction activity may proceed as planned. No activity is allowed within 25m of a grave or burial site.
