*RE: Van Wyk-Rowe, C., August 2013. Documentation Report For Late Iron Age Stone Walled Settlements RDR 1, 2 & RDR 7 Within The Proposed Development Area (Morning Tide Complex), On The Remainder Of Portion 7 Of The Farm Roodraai 34 JT, Mashishing (Lydenburg) Mpumalanga Province.*

SAHRA has received the above mentioned report from the archaeologist assessing the area for further archaeological mitigation as requested by SAHRA.

During this assessment Ms van Wyk-Rowe identified ten rock engravings which were not recorded in the original archaeological impact assessment of 2006 because of the thick vegetation. These rock engravings, located close to site RDR 1 (I, J & K), are of high significance and as such must be conserved.

SAHRA requires that the rock engravings be fenced off during construction and a Conservation Management Plan be compiled to ensure conservation and proper management of these resources.
