Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the case. The KZN AMAFI and Research Institute has reviewed the heritage impact assessment provided by Umlando. The proposed development is partly in a dense coastal dune Forrest which was impossible to survey due to it's density.

The Heritage survey on page 27, remarked that one pot sherd was found which indicate more heritage resources might be present. We therefore require that the heritage practitioner must be employed for the initial foundation phase of the pipeline to monitor if any heritage resources might be disturbed. If anything is found, a rescue excavation must be conducted to retrieve any significant finds.
