Final Comment

The proposed development entails upgrading of the M30/K50 (Garsfontein Road) in Gauteng Province. The author notes that no sites of archaeological cultural heritage significance were identified within the project study area.

Butler, E. October 2020. Palaeontological Desktop Assessment For The Proposed M30/K50 (Garsfontein Road) Upgrade, Gauteng Province

The author notes that the proposed development is in the Transvaal Basin and is underlain by the Timeball Hill and Hekpoort Formations (Pretoria Group, Transvaal Supergroup) as well as unfossiliferous diabase. As the M30/K50 (Garsfontein Road) Upgrade will be within the existing road reserve it will not lead to detrimental impacts on the palaeontological heritage of the area. The author also recommends that, if fossil remains are discovered during any phase of construction, either on the surface or exposed by excavations, the Chance Find Protocol must be implemented by the Environmental Control Officer in charge of the project.

Final Comment

In terms of archaeological and palaeontological heritage, the SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites Unit has no objections to this proposed development, provided that the recommendations in the specialist reports and this comment are adhered to, and in addition, on the following conditions:

- If any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g., remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments and charcoal/ash concentrations) or palaeontological remains are found during the proposed activities, SAHRA must be alerted immediately, and a

professional archaeologist or palaeontologist, based on the nature of the finds, must be contacted as soon as possible to inspect the findings. If the newly discovered heritage resources prove to be of significance a Phase 2 rescue operation might be necessary.

If any unmarked human burials are uncovered and the archaeologist called in to inspect the finds and/or the police find them to be heritage graves, mitigation may be necessary and the SAHRA Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit must be contacted for processes to follow.

Should the project be granted Environmental Authorisation, SAHRA must be notified and all relevant documents submitted to the case on SAHRIS.
