Thank you for your indication that a road upgrade will take place along the DR08017 from Mt Frere to Cederville for a total length of 10.7km.

Decision:

In terms of the National Heritage Resources Act, no 25 of 1999, heritage resources, including archaeological or palaeontological sites over 100 years old, graves older than 60 years, structures older than 60 years are protected. They may not be disturbed without a permit from the relevant heritage resources authority. This means that before such sites are disturbed by development it is incumbent on the developer to ensure that Heritage **Impact** Assessment is done. This must include the archaeological palaeontological components and any other applicable heritage components. Please note that other heritage resources that may be impacted are built structures over 60 years old, sites of cultural significance associated with oral histories, burial grounds and graves, graves of victims of conflict, and cultural landscapes or viewscapes.
