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## **Final Comment**

The applicant proposes to construct approximately 3.8 km of sewer pipeline which will be 250mm in diameter. The pipeline will originate from the current Illovo Country Club (in the process of being upgraded to the Illovo Country Estate) to a proposed Pump Station. From the Pump Station, the pipeline will connect to the existing South Coast Sewer Pump Station. The pipeline is located within road reserves and sugarcane fields. It is located in Illovo, Kwa-Zulu Natal

Thank you for the invitation for comment with regards to the notification of intention to develop the sewer reticulation. It is noted in the Basic Assessment Report that the pipeline will traverse a largely disturbed area. Interrogation of the archaeology database does not reflect sites along the proposed area. For this reason development may proceed as planned taking into consideration the standard conditions highlighted below.

## Conditions:

- 1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
- 2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
